

Gaming proceeds can be used to purchase uniform/costume items if they are essential to the delivery of the organization's charitable programs or services, as follows:

1. Ownership of the item remains with the licensed group. Items of a personal, social or promotional nature may not be purchased.
2. The item is required for competitive play, practice or artistic performances. It must include a distinctive logo or markings.
3. The item is used by players/participants only during the normal season, and is returned to the licensed group at the end of the season.
4. Players/participants do not use the item for activities not related to games, practices or performances.

A written policy must be developed if a group wishes to use gaming proceeds for this purpose, and provided to the Alberta Gaming and Liquor Commission upon request.
