TO ENABLE A PERSON TO PLAY A VIDEO LOTTERY TERMINAL

RULES OF PLAY:

- Any malfunction voids all plays and pays.
- If a Video Lottery Terminal appears to be malfunctioning, play should be discontinued and reported to site staff immediately. A cashout ticket is produced when 5000 credits or \$1250 is attained with the balance of the credits remaining on the terminal until played or cashed out.
- 4000 credits (\$1000) is the maximum that can be won on a single spin.
- Video Lottery Cashout tickets must be claimed within seven (7) days from the date they were issued.
- Cashout tickets can only be redeemed at the Video Lottery Retailer from where they were issued.
- Alberta law prohibits this establishment from permitting a person who is apparently intoxicated by liquor or a drug to take part in any gaming activity conducted in this licensed premises.
- No person under the age of 18 is permitted to play Video Lottery Terminals.
